

**ORDINANCE NO. 68-B**

**THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, KIT CARSON COUNTY, COLORADO, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDAIN TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NUMBER 88-A PROVIDING FOR TWO REGULAR MONTHLY MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO, AND TO INSTEAD PROVIDE FOR ONE MONTHLY MEETING**

**Whereas**, the Town of Stratton, hereinafter referred to as the "Town", in the County of Kit Carson, and the State of Colorado, is the body corporate operating as a statutory town pursuant to the general statutes of the State of Colorado; and

**Whereas**, since September 10, 1998, the Board of Trustees for the Town of Stratton, hereinafter referred to as the "Board", has in accordance with Ordinance No. 88-A, held regular meetings of the Board on the second and fourth Thursday of each month, beginning at the hour of 7:00 P.M.; and

**Whereas**, the Board has determined that one regular meeting, per month, is sufficient to conduct Town business provided that the Board may call additional monthly special meetings and workshops, when needed, in accordance with the Colorado Open Meetings Law, as amended;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO:**

**SECTION I. - REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING**

Regular meetings of the Board of Trustees for the Town of Stratton, Colorado, shall be held on the second Thursday of each month beginning at the hour of 7:00 P.M. Meetings shall be held at 918 Colorado Avenue, Stratton, Colorado, unless moved with prior notice by a required posting of the meeting.

**SECTION II. - SPECIAL MEETINGS AND WORKSHOPS**

Nothing in this Ordinance shall prevent the Board from calling as many special meetings, or holding workshops, in addition to the regular meeting all in accordance with the Colorado Open Meetings Law, should the Board determine that public business requires additional meetings of the Board in any particular month.

**SECTION II. - SEPARABILITY**

If any one or more sections or parts of this Ordinance shall be adjudged unenforceable or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, it being the intention that the various provisions hereof are severable.

**SECTION III. - REPEALER**

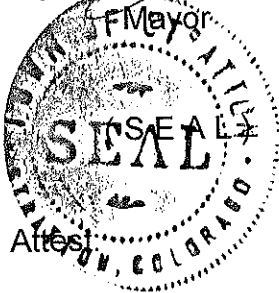
All acts, orders, resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof, of the Town that are inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance, including Ordinance No. 88-A, are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.

**SECTION IV. - IMMEDIATE PASSAGE - EMERGENCY**

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton has determined that the change in the number of monthly regular meetings should take place immediately. Accordingly, the Board finds that an emergency exists and declares that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
