

ORDINANCE NO. 87-A

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC BY THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO AMENDING ORDINANCE 81A (ADOPTING THE 1995 EDITION OF THE "MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO MUNICIPALITIES" BY ADDITION OF PARAGRAPH 613 REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO:

Section 1. Ordinance 81A of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, enacted December 15, 1995 adopting the 1995 edition of the "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities," promulgated and published as such by the Colorado Department of Transportation, is hereby amended by addition of the following paragraph 613, in Part 6 (Signals - Signs - Markings) of said "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities":

613. Designation of Highway Maintenance, repair, or construction zones - signs - increase in penalties for speeding violations.

(1) If maintenance, repair, or construction activities are occurring or will be occurring within four hours on a state highway or municipal street, the department of transportation or municipal authorities, within their respective jurisdictions, may designate such portion of the highway as a highway maintenance, repair, or construction zone. Any person who commits a speeding violation in a maintenance, repair, or construction zone that is designated pursuant to the provisions of this section is subject to increased penalties and surcharges.


(2) The Department of transportation or municipal authorities, within their respective jurisdictions, shall designate by appropriate signs a maintenance, repair, or construction activity is taking place or will be taking place within four hours. Such sign shall notify the public that increased penalties for speeding violations are in effect in such zone. The department of transportation or local authorities shall erect or place a second sign after such zone indicating that the increased penalties for speeding violations are no longer in effect. A maintenance, repair or construction zone begins at the location of the sign indicating that increased penalties are in effect and ends at the location of the sign that the increased penalties are no longer in effect.

(3) Signs used for designating the beginning and end of a maintenance, construction, or repair zone shall conform to department of transportation requirements. The department of transportation or local authority may display

such signs on any fixed, variable, or moveable stand. The department of transportation or local authority may place such a sign on a moving vehicle if required for certain activities, including, but not limited to, highway painting work.

Section 2. The Board finds and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and, therefore, an emergency exists, and this ordinance, shall be recorded in the Book of Ordinances of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and attested by the Clerk under the corporate seal of the Town and shall be published in "The Stratton Spotlight," a public weekly newspaper published within the corporate limits of the Town of Stratton and the County of Kit Carson and State of Colorado and shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.


