

RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES
RESOLUTION 2023-05

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2023, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO, FOR THE 2024 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton, Colorado has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law on December 18, 2023, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$104,552 and;

WHEREAS, the 2023 valuation for assessment for the Town of Stratton as certified by the County Assessor is \$3,614,974;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operation expenses of the Town of Stratton during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 28.922 mills, assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 2024.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Kit Carson County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Stratton as hereinabove determined and set.
