Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operation expenses of the Town of Stratton during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 28.922 mills, amended by a temporary reduction of Mills to 26.833. assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 2024.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Kit Carson County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Stratton as hereinabove determined and set.
