RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES RESOLUTION 2025-03

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2025, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO, FOR THE 2026 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton, Colorado has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law on December 4, 2025, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$109,042 and;

WHEREAS, the 2025 valuation for assessment for the Town of Stratton as certified by the County Assessor is \$5,242,420;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operation expenses of the Town of Stratton during the 2026 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 28.274 mills, with a temporary reduction of Mills to 20.800, assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 2026.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Kit Carson County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Stratton as hereinabove determined and set.
